LLEC encourages you to conserve energy in your home and at work. By participating in our energy efficiency programs, you can keep costs down and earn rebates when you purchase and install lighting equipment in new buildings, additions to existing buildings, or major renovations of an existing building.

What products are eligible for the rebate?

The following equipment is eligible for the New Construction Lighting Rebates. Please see lighting table on page 4 of the Lighting New Construction Rebate Application form for more details.

- Fluorescent T5 Lamps with Electronic Ballast
- Low-wattage T8 Lamps
- High-bay Fluorescent T5HO, T8 and T8VHO Lamps with Electronic Ballasts
- Ceramic Metal Halide Fixtures4
- Pulse-Start Metal Halide Fixtures
- Super T8 Lamps with Electronic Ballast
(Note: Super T8 systems must meet the following CEE specifications:
 - Lamps: Initial lumens = 3,100; color rendering index (CRI) > 81; mean lumens per watt > 90 (instant start ballasts) or > 88 (programmed rapid start ballasts); lamp life >24,000 hours at (3 hrs/start); and lumen maintenance > 94%
- Ballasts: Must meet or exceed minimum ballast efficacy factor (BEF) shown in the table below. (note: BF = ballast factor)

How Do I Qualify?

1. General Qualifications

- Rebate applies to indoor lighting programs only. Rebates will not be given for outdoor lighting.
- Rebates will be given directly to the members and will not be given to Lighting Suppliers or Contractors.

2. Application—Limited Funds

- This program is offered from January 1 through December 31 of the respective calendar year. Rebate requests are processed on a “first-come first-serve” basis. Annual rebate funds are limited. Rebate programs, qualifications, and amounts are subject to change at any time. The customer is responsible for checking with Lyon-Lincoln Electric Cooperative to determine whether the program is still in effect.
- The minimum rebate application is \$50.00. The maximum rebate amount is \$2,000 per customer per calendar year and is limited to up to 50% of the project costs.

3. Inspection and Verification

- The Cooperative reserves the right to conduct inspections of any and all installations to verify that all the program rules and requirements have been complied with. If the cooperative finds that the customer has not complied with its rules and standards, any rebated the customer has received must be returned to the cooperative.

4. Equipment Eligibility Requirements

- All equipment must be new and meet specification requirements.

5. Tax Information

- The Cooperative will not be responsible for any tax liability imposed as a result of the rebate payments. Consumers are advised to consult their tax advisors before submitting rebate requests.

6. Disclaimer

- The Cooperative gives no warranties, expressed or implied, with respect to equipment operation, material, workmanship or manufacturing. The Cooperative does not guarantee that the implementation of energy-efficient measures or use of equipment purchased or installed pursuant to this program will result in energy or cost savings. In no event shall the Cooperative be liable for any incidental or consequential damage.

7. Privacy

- Information contained in this rebate application may be shared with the Department of Commerce.

8. Rebate Exclusions

- Rebates will not be given for equipment or designs that do not comply with local, state or federal regulations.
- The Cooperative is not liable for rebates promised to a customer as a result of a contractor misrepresenting the program.
- Customers must apply for rebates within a year of the purchase date shown on the equipment invoice.
